# 2025 Emergency Services Regatta

#### Note:

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in the NOR and SI's means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. This change RRS 60.5(c).

The notation '[NP]' denotes that a breach of this rule will not be grounds for protest by boat. This changes RRS 60.1

The notation '[SP]' denotes a rule for which a standard penalty will be applied by the race committee without a hearing as allowed by RRS 60.5b(3).

#### **Rules**

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 The prescriptions and special regulations of Australian Sailing (AS), as may be amended [DP],
- 1.3 World Sailing's Equipment Rules of Sailing 2025-2028 (ERS) [DP]
- In the event of conflict between any of the rules or regulations, other than RRS, the Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.5(c).
- 1.5 The penalty for breaking a rule of Part 2 shall be a One Turn Penalty (one tack and one gybe in the same direction) except that for infringements within the Zone, as defined in the RRS, the penalty shall be a Two Turns Penalty (two tacks and two gybes in the same direction). This changes RRS 44.2.
- 1.6 This is a non-spinnaker Regatta a boat may only use one headsail and one mainsail only. Spinnakers, Gennakers, Code Zeros etc. are not permitted to be used.
- 1.7 RRS Appendix T Arbitration will apply.

2.2 The Race Committee may make changes to this Schedule in case of vagaries in the weather or as required.

#### **Courses**

- 4.1 The courses to be sailed shall be indicated on the **Race Committee Box (RCB)** or the **Race Committee Vessel (RCV)** prior to the first warning signal by displaying the appropriate course flag as set out in Appendix A1 for Windward Leeward courses and Appendix A3 for Bay & Pulbah courses.
- 4.2 A map showing the approximate locations of the course areas is included in Appendix A2.

#### **Marks**

- 5.1 For Bay & Pulbah Courses; LMYC permanent marks a lime green cylinder approximately 1.2 m high x 300mm diameter with a red band and a yellow cone atop. Pulbah Island and Wangi Point are the landforms so named.
- 5.2 For Windward / Leeward Courses; Marks A & B will be a Yellow inflatable truncated marks 1250 mm high, 500 mm diameter at top and 1025 mm diameter at base with a red band 300 mm wide with LMYC logo in the middle. The Start & Finish Mark will also be Mark B.

#### Start/Finish Line's

- 6.1 *Monday 17<sup>th</sup> November 2025* 
  - The start/finish line will be a line drawn between the Race Committee Box (RCB) on the SW corner of the LMYC marina and the Start/Finish mark (Marks). A lime green inner distance mark shall be taken on the same hand as the RCB when starting or finishing.
- 6.2 Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> November 2025

  The start/finish line will be between a mast displaying an orange flag on the Race Committee Vessel (RCV) and Mark B.

#### Recalls

7.1 Individual Recalls shall be in accordance with RRS 29.

In addition the Race Officer (RO) may broadcast on VHF radio (Chan 71) the sail number of a boat that is On Course Side (OCS). A failure to make such broadcast or to receive such broadcast will not be considered as grounds for redress. (Changes RRS 62.1(a))

#### **Communications**

- 8.1 All Race Communications shall be broadcasted on VHF Radio (Chan 71).
- A boat retiring before, during or after a race shall notify the RO of its intention to do so by calling the RO on mobile: 0414 450 022 or VHF (Channel 71) at the earliest opportunity. The boat will be scored DNF. (Changes RRS 63.1 and A4) Any boat retiring from a race and failing to advise the RC will be scored DNC. (Changes RRS 63.1 and A5.3)

#### **Target Times & Time Limits**

- 9.1 The target time for the first boat in each Windward/Leeward race will be 40 minutes.
- 9.2 Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for protest.
- 9.3 Time limits from each Groups Starting Signal:
  - Windward Leeward races shall be 1.0 hour:
  - Pulbah & Bay courses shall be 3.5 hrs.
- 9.4 Yachts not finishing within their time limit will be recorded as TLE (which is equal to numbers of finishers +1). This changes RRS35.

#### **Prohibited Areas**

- 10.1 A Boat shall not pass between any permanent mooring, whether occupied or not, and the nearby shoreline.
- 10.2 Unoccupied permanent moorings are obstructions for the purpose of RRS 19.2(a & b) and are prohibited areas. Boats moored to permanent moorings are continuing obstructions for the purpose of RRS 19.2(c).
- 10.3 A boat shall not come into contact with a permanent mooring or a boat moored on a permanent mooring. A boat that does so shall complete a one-turn penalty in compliance with RRS 44.2 This changes RRS 44.1. If the incident resulted in any damage whatsoever, it shall be reported to the RC. If required, an incident report shall also be provided to Transport for NSW.
- 10.4 All Cardinal navigation marks shall be passed on their safe waterside.
- 10.5 For the on-water safety of junior sailors, the Belmont 16s Club will raise a 900mm x 900mm pink flag on its RCV when their start and finish lines are in active operation. Any boat sailing through the active line will incur a DPI equal to 25% of starters without a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and Appendix A5.2. The Race Committee may also protest a boat for a serious breach of SI 14.5.

#### Race results and scoring

Results will be calculated on TCF handicap with the lowest corrected time scored first, the next lowest corrected time second, and so on. (Refer RRS A4, A5.2)

#### **Prizes**

12.1 Prizes will be awarded at the Results Presentation and at the discretion of the NSW Police & Emergency Services Sailing Club.


