NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS OPEN TWILIGHT RACE

Friday 30th January 2026

Lake Macquarie Yacht Club Open Twilight race - is part of the Lakefest Festival on Lake Macquarie. It is a **fun race** – no spinnakers, and you don't have to be the fastest to win! Prizes will be awarded by the organizers to yachts by random draw at the LMYC Clubhouse after the race.

Venue: Lake Macquarie Yacht Club

Open to: All sailing boats with a current Category 7 or above safety certificate.

Entry: Entry is free. All boats currently entered in the WASC or LMYC Friday night twilight series will be automatically entered. All other boats must register at the LMYC bar.
Closing time for entries 17:00 hours on day of race.

RULES:

1. The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS)
2. Spinnakers and Gennakers may not be used.
3. Start will be South of Coal Point, between the LMYC Committee boat bearing an orange flag and start mark bearing an orange flag at the port end of the line. An inner distance mark may be placed near the committee boat and all boats shall leave it on the same side as the Committee boat.
4. All Divisions will start in accordance with RRS26. There will be 3 Divisions.
Warning signals: Div.1 - 17:40 Div. 2 - 17:45 Div. 3 – 17:50
5. Finish will be between the LMYC club race box and the LMYC Club/Finish mark. leaving the inner distance mark on the same side as the race box.
6. The courses will be as per attachment A
Mark locations and descriptions as per Attachment B
7. In the event of a fading wind, the course may be shortened at any mark.
8. Any boats retiring are required to advise the LMYC RO on 0414450022 or VHF 71
9. Participants will need to be at the presentation to claim their prize

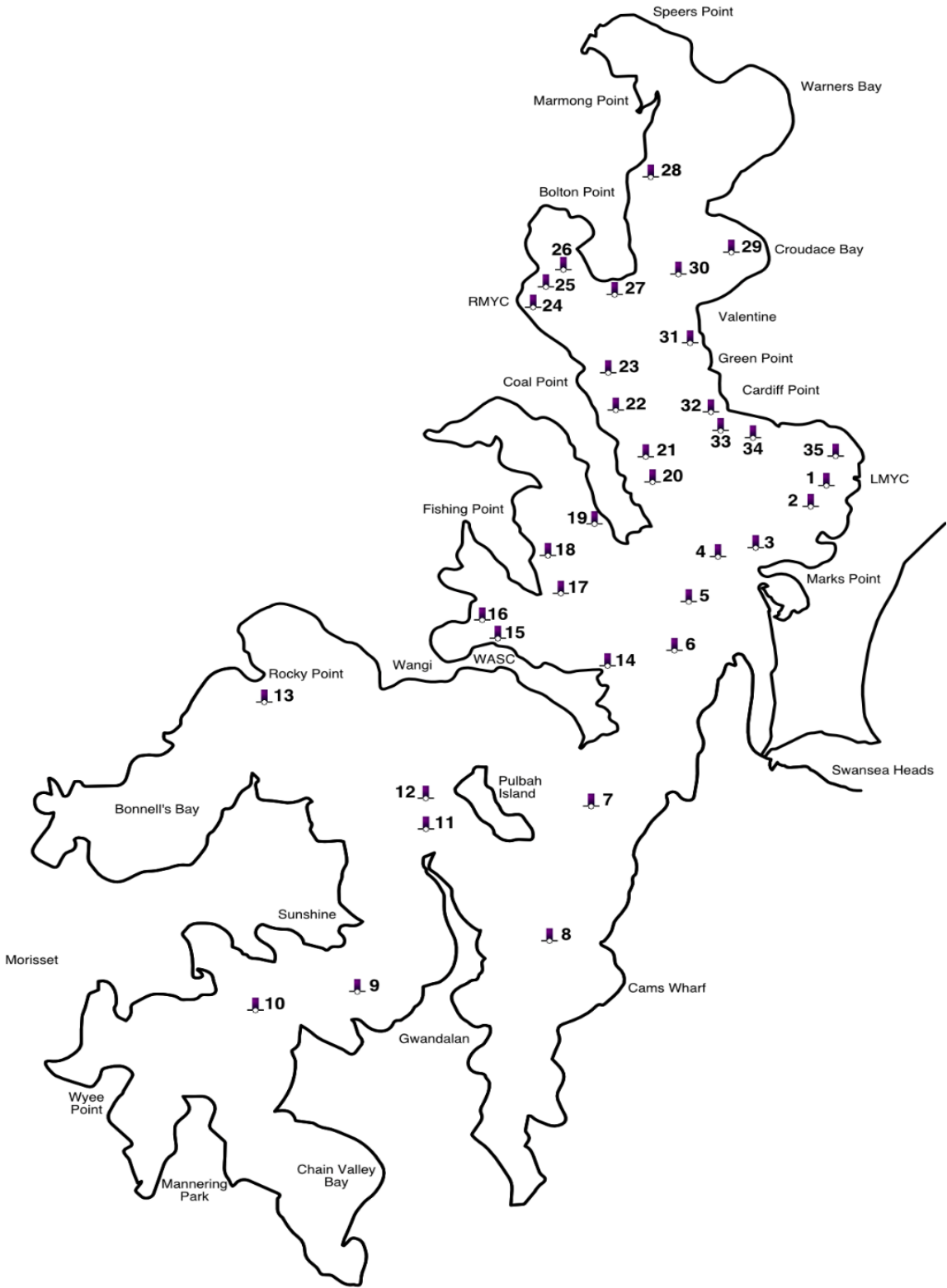

Marks, shall be lime green cylinders approximately 1300mm high and 300mm in diameter, with a yellow or lime green cap, a 150mm wide red band approximately 400mm down from the top and the letters LMYC.
