



AMENDMENT TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

“Notice of Race Sailing Instructions Sailing Program and Courses 2025-2026” (LMYC Whitebook)

AMENDMENT 2

1. LMYC currently has twelve (12) laid marks throughout Lake Macquarie. Eleven (11) of these marks have now been replaced with new ones. The new LMYC Marks are all yellow buoys with black letters ‘LMYC’ vertically on the centre post and are approximately (~) 1100mm high & ~ 300mm in diameter with a ~700mm base:



The LMYC mark which has NOT been replaced is the IDM on the eastern end of the Clubhouse RCB Start/Finish line which currently remains as a lime green cylinder mark ~1300mm high & ~300mm in diameter.

The following **Amendments** have been made in the LMYC Whitebook (v3):

2.15 MARKS

2.15.1 Marks referred to in 9. COURSE SCHEDULE of these SIs, shall be **yellow** cylinder **buoys** approximately **1100mm** high and 300mm in diameter, **with black vertical** letters LMYC.

‘Pulbah’ and ‘Wangi Point’ are the landforms so named.

5.5 START/FINISH LINES CLUB HOUSE RCB

5.5.2 The LMYC Club Mark shall be a **yellow** cylinder **buoy** approximately **1100mm** high and 300mm in diameter, **with black vertical** letters LMYC. An IDM being a lime green cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.

6. START / FINISH LINES

6.5.2 The LMYC Club Mark shall be a **yellow** cylinder **buoy** approximately **1100mm** high and 300mm in diameter, **with black vertical** letters LMYC. An inner distance LMYC Mark shall be a lime green cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.

7.5 START / FINISH LINES

7.5.2 The LMYC Club Mark shall be a **yellow** cylinder **buoy** approximately **1100mm** high and 300mm in diameter, **with black vertical** letters LMYC. An IDM being a lime green cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.
