1. SUNDAY WINTER – Sweepstake/Pointscore Courses

Changes to Course No 7 (Westerly) & No 8 (N-Westerly) – Changing Carey Bay mark to **Cardiff Pt**
Changes to Course No 9 (Swansea), listing Channel as a Passing Mark (PM) to **P & S** appropriately

2. Change of IDM Mark (Inner Distance Mark) - from a lime green cylinder to a yellow buoy with black letters ‘LMYC’ vertically on the centre post and is approximately (~) 1100mm high & ~ 300mm in diameter with a ~700mm base:

- 2.13.1 To comply with RRS 30.1 I Flag Rule, at the Clubhouse RCB start line, a boat may round either the **yellow** cylinder mark which shall serve as the IDM on the eastern end of the start line or the Club mark on the western end of the start line.
- 3.4.4 At the Clubhouse RCB start/finish line the LMYC Club Mark shall be a mark as described in SI 2.15. An IDM being a **yellow** cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.
- 5.5.2 The LMYC Club Mark shall be a yellow cylinder buoy approximately 1100mm high and 300mm in diameter, with black vertical letters LMYC. An IDM being a **yellow** cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.
- 6.5.2 The LMYC Club Mark shall be a yellow cylinder buoy approximately 1100mm high and 300mm in diameter, with black vertical letters LMYC. An inner distance LMYC Mark shall be a **yellow** cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.
- 7.5.2 The LMYC Club Mark shall be a yellow cylinder buoy approximately 1100mm high and 300mm in diameter, with black vertical letters LMYC. An IDM being a **yellow** cylinder shall be moored near the eastern end of the Club House start/finish line and shall be left on the same hand as the RCB when starting/finishing.
